CONTEST DIRECTIONS

All entries should reflect a student's interpretation of the Law Day 2024 theme. Be as creative as you like! You might also be inspired by these suggestions:

- 1. Illustrate citizens exercising their right to vote.
- 2. Depict an honest and civil debate between political candidates.
- 3. Create an infographic on some aspect of the electoral process.

The contest is open to students in grades 3-12. A Certificate of Recognition will be awarded to all artists and artwork will be displayed in the federal courthouses in Hartford, New Haven, and Bridgeport.

- Artwork should be in the form of drawings, paintings, photographs, digital photos, graphic art, etc.
- Size should be 8.5"x11" or larger.
