

FRAUD ALERT: In various parts of the United States, citizens are being targeted by scammers asserting that arrest warrants have been issued by the Judges of the District of Connecticut for failure to appear.

Recipients are sometimes pressured to provide confidential data, potentially leading to identify theft and fraud. These calls, which threaten recipients with fines and jail time if they do not comply, are fraudulent and are not connected to the U.S. District Court.

Federal courts do not require anyone to provide any sensitive information in a telephone call or email. Most contact between the federal court and an individual will be through the U.S. Mail, and any telephone contact by court officials will not include threats of arrest, or requests for Social Security Numbers, credit card numbers, or any other sensitive information.
