INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR JURORS

In the event of inclement weather, jurors will be notified of any cancellations or delays as soon as possible using the telephone contact information you have provided to the Court.

If there are updated reporting instructions due to the weather, the Court will notify jurors the night before, or as early as possible on the morning jurors are scheduled to report for service.

Jurors may call the toll- free number (1-866-388-2430) at any time for updated reporting instructions.

- **Jury Selections.** For jury selections scheduled early in the morning, prospective jurors will receive an automated call from the Court with a pre-recorded message that will provide any updated reporting instructions.
- **Impaneled Jurors.** For impaneled jurors already selected to serve on a trial, a representative of the presiding judge's chambers will contact jurors and provide specific reporting instructions. For this reason, those jurors are asked to provide a telephone number where they may be reached during the duration of the trial. If there has been no communication from the judge's chambers, please call the toll-free number for updated reporting instructions.
- **Grand Jurors.** Grand jurors impaneled to serve on a grand jury will receive an automated telephone call from the Court with a pre-recorded message that will provide any updated reporting instructions.
