**STANDING ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF NEXTGEN CM/ECF**

CM/ECF e-filing for the District of Connecticut will suspend operations on Friday, December 8, 2017 at noon when the conversion to NextGen CM/ECF begins. No Notices of Electronic Filing will issue after Friday December 8, 2017 at noon until NextGen CM/ECF becomes operational on Monday, December 11, 2017. An extension for electronic filing will be granted for all documents due between Friday, December 8, 2017 at 12:01 p.m. and Sunday, December 10, 2017 at 11:59 p.m. All such documents must be efiled no later than midnight, Monday, December 11, 2017.

Documents with special circumstances will be accepted via email to QualityControl@ctd.uscourts.gov. These documents will be limited to those with a statute of limitations deadline, emergency injunctive relief, and notices of appeal. Documents submitted by e-mail will be deemed filed as of the date they were received, and will be entered on the docket by the Clerk's Office as soon as practical.

Information will be posted on our website notifying the public when NextGen CM/ECF is operational. At that time, users will be able to e-file and see dockets in PACER using their upgraded PACER accounts. Previously issued CM/ECF logins and passwords will no longer be operational and all e-filing will be accomplished through PACER.
