

Laptop computers are prohibited in the federal courthouses in the District of Connecticut, except they may be possessed by:

1. Attorneys who display a Connecticut Judicial Branch-issued Attorney Photo ID Card or any other identification that sufficiently establishes that they are attorneys visiting the courthouse on official business;
2. The United States Attorney, Assistant U.S. Attorneys, the Federal Defender, and Assistant Federal Defenders;
3. Judges and their chambers staff;
4. Employees of the Clerk's Office; and
5. Other individuals permitted by the Court.

This policy is effective October 16, 2013.
