AMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF OCTOBER 5, 2017

That is, the members of the Merit Selection Panel who were appointed on October 5, 2017, and who are eligible to apply for a magistrate judge position, are restricted from applying for such a position for one year.
