APPOINTMENT OF A UNITED STATES  
MAGISTRATE JUDGE MERIT SELECTION PANEL

**SUPERSEDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

Pursuant to the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. Sections 631, et seq., and the further authority granted by the Judicial Conference of the United States, the Board of Judges for the District of Connecticut hereby appoints Raymond F. Pursuant to Judicial Conference Policy the members of this Merit Selection Panel who are eligible to apply for a magistrate judge position, are restricted from applying for such a position for one year from the date of this Order, and they were notified by letter on or before April 20, 2023.

It is further ORDERED that the Panel report to the Court whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment within ninety (90) days of appointment. The Panel must review the incumbent's current service as magistrate judge and other experience, the comments from members of the bar and public, and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, ability, and

commitment to equal justice under the law. A written report must be submitted by no later than July 10, 2023.
