These documents will be limited to those with a statute of limitations deadline, emergency injunctive relief, and notices of appeal. Documents submitted by e-mail will be deemed filed as of the date they were received, and will be entered on the docket by the Clerk's Office as soon as practical.

Information will be posted on our website notifying the public when NextGen CM/ECF Version 1.7 is operational.
