**ORDER AUTHORIZING DEIRDRE DALY TO BE THE  
INTERIM UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FOR THE  
DISTRICT OF CONNECTICUT  
DURING A VACANCY IN THAT OFFICE**

On December 10, 2013, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 546, Eric H. Holder, Jr., Attorney General, entered an order designating and appointing Deirdre Daly to be the United States Attorney for the District of Connecticut and to serve in that capacity for the period of 120 days or until a Presidential appointee qualified under 28 U.S.C. § 512, whichever occurred first. The appointment was effective on December 10, 2013.

To date, no Presidential appointee has qualified. Moreover, April 9, 2014, will mark the expiration of 120 days after appointment by the Attorney General, thereby creating a vacancy.

In view of this vacancy, and pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 546(d), the undersigned, acting for and on behalf of the Judges of the above-entitled Court, hereby designates and appoints Deirdre Daly to be the United States Attorney for the District of Connecticut and to serve in that capacity until the vacancy is filled.
